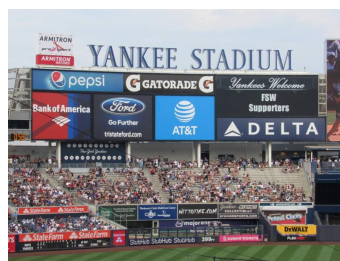


Program Updates

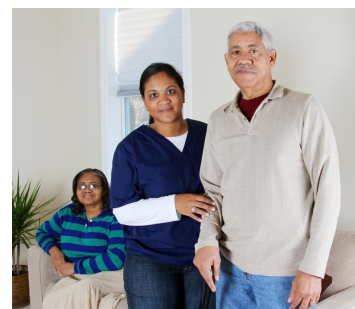
DADS TAKE YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL DAY

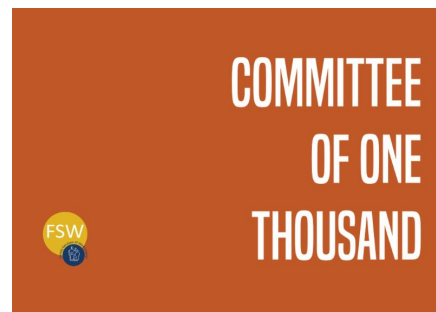
