Notifying the Public of Rights under Title VI

Family Services of Westchester (FSW) operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, or national origin, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.

To obtain additional information about your rights under Title VI, contact Family Services of Westchester.

If you believe you have been discriminated against on the basis of race, color, or national origin by FSW, you may file a Title VI complaint by completing, signing, and submitting the agency's Title VI Complaint Form.

How to file a Title VI complaint with FSW:

In addition to the complaint process at FSW, complaints may be filed directly with the Federal Transit Administration, Office of Civil Rights, Region VII, 901 Locust Street, Suite 404, Kansas City, MO 64106.

Complaints must be filed within 180 days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence and should contain as much detailed information about the alleged discrimination as possible. The form must be signed, dated and include your contact information.
