The Prime Time Program fosters a positive developmentally appropriate environment that gives each child individual support he or she needs to play, learn, grow and thrive.

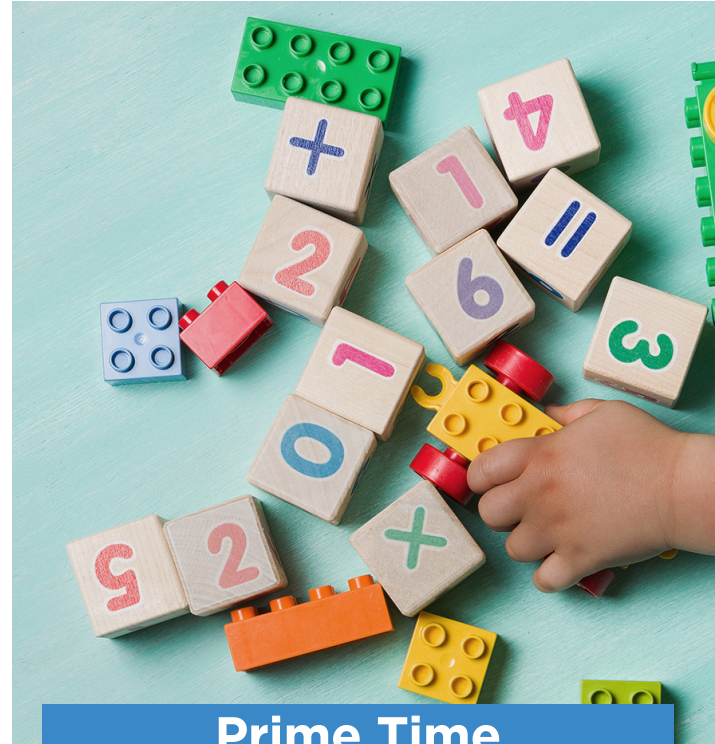
We believe that learning should foster the physical, emotional, and social development of each student.

Prime Time is a 4410 Program approved by the New York State Department of Education, to offer speech therapy, occupational therapy, and physical therapy for children with developmental and/or learning disabilities.

Our organization is in partnership with the State Education Department and local school districts in Westchester and Putnam Counties.







## About Us

FSW's Prime Time Therapeutic Preschool offers a comprehensive range of individualized educational programming and therapeutic services.

Prime Time provides preschoolers aged 2.8 through 5 with a nurturing, supportive, language-enriched classroom experience.

In our structured classrooms, teachers take innovative steps to ensure that all students flourish in meeting their individualized goals.

Our childcare facility provides a safe and fun environment, filled with exciting activities to keep young minds engaged. Children are in session for 5 hours daily.

Prime Time Therapeutic Preschool hours of operation are Monday through Friday from 8:30 AM to 1:30 PM. Our Integrated class (SCIS) hours are 8:15 AM to 1:15 PM.

## Eligibility

To visit our school or learn more, we request that you first confirm your child's eligibility through your local Committee on Preschool Special Education (CPSE). CPSE will verify that your child is eligible for one of the following:

- (1) Initial placement in a center-based program
- (2) Transition from Early Intervention or
- (3) Seeking a transfer from another special education preschool program
